## CONDITIONS OF AWARDS

### Field of Study

Any program that leads to an Undergraduate Degree, a Certificate in Technical Studies, or a specialized field of study.

### Eligibility

Eligibility is limited to dependents of active members in good standing with Local 1620 for at least twelve (12) consecutive months and is the dependent child, grandchild (natural or adopted) of Local 1620 members.

If membership is terminated before a scholarship winner receives full payment, subsequent payments will be forfeited.

The recipient of the Construction Scholarship will **not** be eligible for the Utility Scholarship in the same year.

### Number of Awards

The first scholarship is open to the Construction sector membership only and is for \$3,000.00 – to be issued in four increments of \$750.00 for the first two years while attending a recognized post-secondary institution. If the winner of this scholarship does not return after the first year, the remainder of the scholarship will be forfeited.

The second scholarship is open to all of Local 1620's membership and is for \$1,500.00 to be divided equally for each semester of the first year while attending a recognized post-secondary institution. If the winner of this scholarship does not return after the first semester, the remainder of the scholarship will be forfeited.

### Where Valid

The awards are valid at any accredited university or college affiliated with a university or a technical institute.

### Qualifications

Candidates must have fulfilled the requirements for a High School certificate. **Candidates must submit their Public or Final Exam Marks to the Union Office.** They need to be graduating from High School in 2024 and planning to enter their first year of studies at a Post-Secondary Institution in the **2024-2025** Academic Year. **Candidates should ensure that Reference Letters are sent to the Union Office as soon as possible.** Selection will be based on an assessment of the Application, the Public or Final Exam Marks, References and Extra Curricular Activities. **Incomplete files will not be considered.**

## **Responsibility of Award Recipients**

Award recipients must be prepared to enter a course of study in the year of application. Requests for deferment will be considered only in unusual circumstances such as illness or limited admission to a program. The final decision for allowing deferments will be made by the Selection Committee.
